Strategic Themes Workshop

In January 2017, the Conwy & Denbighshire Public Services Board held a workshop to begin discussing the implications of the draft Local Well-being Assessment and what this means to the Conwy and Denbighshire region.

The board discussed the strategic issues raised in the local well-being assessment and began to consider where they can make a difference collectively.

After prioritising the issues, the Board identified two areas requiring further investigation as part of a response analysis, these were -

- Creating a Healthy Way of Life
- Creating an aspirational and emotionally literate culture among young people

To inform the response analysis, the Board plans to engage with key stakeholders in these areas to gain a better understanding of the current situation, identifying gaps & developing proposals for collaborative working.

Local Well-being Assessment – Consultation

Under the Act, the PSB has to prepare and publish an assessment on the state of the economic, social, environmental and cultural well-being of Conwy and Denbighshire which will inform the development of a Well-being Plan for the board.

The first draft of the assessment has been produced and will be published on the PSB website (www.conwyanddenbighshirepsb.org.uk) for consultation in early February 2017 - we'll be in contact to let you know when the consultation is up & running so you can have your say.

PSB Interim Priority – 1st 1000 Days of Life

In addition to the issues identified at the recent workshop, the PSB will continue to focus on the **1st 1000 Days of Life**.
